**THE ADOPTION OF NDCC 5-01 AND NDCC 5-02 SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO, NOT IN LIEU OF THE PROVISIONS OF MEDORA CITY CODE CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE 7. IN THE EVENT OF ANY INCONSISTENCIES BETWEEN THE NDCC 5-01 AND 5-02 PROVISIONS AND THE PROVISIONS OF MEDORA CITY CODE CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE 7, CHAPTER 8 ARTICLE 7 SHALL GOVERN.**

**BY EXAMPLE, THE EXCEPTION TO NDCC 5-02-05: MEDORA CITY ORDINANCE GOVERNING DISPENSING HOURS AND DAYS SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:**

**8.0715 Hours and Time of Sale - Penalty** Any person who dispenses or permits the consumption of alcoholic beverages on licensed premises after 1:00 a. m. on Sundays, before 12:00 Noon on Sundays, or between the hours of 1:00 a. m. and 8:00 a. m. on all other days of the week, or who dispenses alcoholic beverages or permits consumption of alcoholic beverages on licensed premises on Christmas Day, after 1:00 a. m. on Thanksgiving Day, or after 6:00 p. m. on Christmas Eve is guilty of an offense. A person that violates this section is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.

**BY EXAMPLE:**

**MEDORA CITY ORDINANCE GOVERNING STREET SALES PROHIBITED SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:**

**8.0721 Street Sales Prohibited** Unless first authorized by a special event permit, the sale, consumption, possession, or service of alcoholic beverages upon or across any street, alley, or public way is prohibited. A person who violates this section shall be guilty of an infraction and sentenced accordingly.
